6 JULY 2020 SITES UPDATE

Pilots *must* adhere to relevant Welsh Government and English government legislation and <u>BHPA advice</u> regarding flying – see the useful references at the bottom of this document. Individuals must decide themselves if they can fly under the relevant legal restrictions and BHPA advice in place for the day for both Welsh and English sites.

It is an absolute requirement that club members abide by the Brecon Beacons National Park Authority (BBNP) closures and prioritise safety and the need for social distancing. Note - some areas of the BBNP close at short notice or are currently closed.

All site rules must be strictly adhered to.

Before considering flying or practicing ground handling at a site, please review the current relevant government advice and laws and consider again whether the activity you are planning is lawful. Do not fly if you feel it is unsafe or unlawful to do so.
